The Central California Blood Center (CCBC) has been helping save lives for more than 50 years and is the sole provider of blood and blood products for the 31 hospitals in Fresno, Tulare, Madera, Kings and Mariposa Counties.

CCBC must collect between 5,000 to 6,000 pints of blood a month to meet the needs of our Central Valley community.

The Central California Blood Center has donor center locations in Central Fresno, North Fresno, Visalia and Porterville. The newly built Jenny Eller Donor Center in Northwest Fresno is also the site of the corporate headquarters.

The Central California Blood Center is licensed by the United State's Food and Drug Administration.

CCBC is accredited by the American Association of Blood Banks (AABB).

The Central California Blood Center is a member of America's Blood Centers (ABC), North America's largest network of non-profit community centers, which collects half of America's blood supply.
